PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE

Class Structure for 2026

We are pleased to share our planned class structure for 2026. After careful planning and consultation with School Council, our class organisation for next year will be:

- 1 × Prep class
- 2 × Year 1 class
- 2 × Year 2 class
- 3 × Year 3/4 class
- 3 × Year 5/6 class

In response to community feedback and our ongoing commitment to strong early years foundations, we will be moving to straight Prep, Year 1 and Year 2 grades in 2026. This structure allows us to further strengthen our early literacy and numeracy programs, streamline support, and ensure a consistent and targeted approach across the early years.

At this stage, due to current student numbers, we are not able to move to straight Year 3, 4, 5 or 6 classes. Our Year 3/4 and Year 5/6 composite classes will continue to offer rich learning opportunities, supported by our whole-school Instructional Model and strong team planning.

These requests help us create balanced, supportive and connected learning communities, and while we cannot make guarantees, we do ensure every child has at least one person from their list.
